- **Bathing:** Lukewarm water, medicated or sensitive-skin shampoo, no heavy scrubbing, and thorough rinsing.
- **Drying:** Soft towel blotting, low warm airflow, and patience.
- **Brushing:** Light strokes with gentle brushes to prevent mats without irritating the skin.
- **Aftercare:** Complete drying, clean bedding, and (if prescribed) vet-approved topical care.

## Quick Tips for Pet Parents

- Keep your pup's bedding freshly washed.
- Avoid strong household cleaners, air fresheners, or scented sprays around your dog.
- Stick to the grooming schedule recommended by your vet and groomer.
- Don't wait if you see redness, sores, or excessive itching — check in with your veterinarian.
- Use Hypoallergenic wipes to clean your dogs face, ears, and paws after they come inside.



## FAQs

**Q: How often should my sensitive-skin dog be groomed?**

A: It depends on their condition, but many benefit from gentle grooming every 1–2 weeks with the right products.

**Q: What if my dog is prescribed medicated shampoo?**
