

# COATOLOGY: SHED HAPPENS

## DESHEDDING: SHORT/MEDIUM DOUBLE COATS




**Breed Examples:** Labrador Retrievers, Pugs, German Shepherds, Corgis, Shiba Inu

**Coat types:** Short/Medium Double Coated

**Heavy Shed Seasons:** March- June, September-November

**Frequency:** At least once a week, 2-3 times a week during heavy shedding seasons



### Tools Needed:



Rubber Brush



Leave-In Conditioner

**Leave-In Conditioner available at Tails Agogo, Rubber Brushes coming soon!**

Using the right tools, shampoos/conditioners, and regular brushing makes a huge difference in managing shedding and keeping the coat healthy. Dogs also go through heavier shedding seasons in the spring and fall, this means they are shedding their thick winter undercoats and may have more fluff than usual.

Remember: always brush in the direction the coat grows



1. Spray the coat with the leave in conditioner. (lightly mist, do not saturate coat)



2. Use the rubber brush in the direction that the fur grows (medium to firm)



3. Check the skin through out brushing for redness or irritation.
