

COATOLOGY: TAME THE MANE

LINE BRUSHING-MEDIUM/LONG COATS



Breed Examples: Yorkshire terriers, Maltese, Shih-tzus, Bichon Frise, All oodles

Coat types: Long, Medium, dense, straight, and Curly hair


Frequency: Medium Coat- 2-3 times a week
Curly/Long Hair- every day to every other day
About 15-20 minutes



Tools Needed:



Slicker Brush



Comb



Leave-In Conditioner

Line brushing is all about brushing your dog's coat in small, manageable sections starting at the paws and working up the body!

By working "line by line," you reach all the way to the skin, helping prevent mats and tangles. Follow the steps below for a smooth, healthy coat!

Remember: always brush in the direction the coat grows



1. Start by creating sections or "lines" of coat



2. Spray the coat with the leave in conditioner. (lightly mist, do not saturate coat)



3. Brush the section with the slicker brush in the direction of the fur.



4. Comb through the brushed section of the coat to ensure that there is not matting, impaction, or tangles left.
